AUSTRALIA



1. **Western Australia 1854 1d black** a stunning four margin stamp with gum. I have never seen such a high quality example of this, the first stamp issued by WA (SG 1). The colour is bright and fresh and there is even part of the unit above still attached, simply perfect and can be yours for **\$999.00**



2. **Kangaroo 5/- grey and yellow** third wmk (SG 42) mint unhinged and well centred, the picture above tells the story of how nice this stamp is! Others may charge up to 40% more for exceptional examples, this one is at our standard price only **\$549.00**
3. **KGV used collection** a full set of KGV heads by watermark (72 stamps) in very fine used condition, in fact some are CTO and all have neat CDS cancels. A beautiful set of stamps for **\$449.00**
4. **Decimal collection** four Seven Seas hingeless albums with maroon binders and slipcases covering the period 1966-1997. Included in the collection are hundreds of mint and used stamps - in fact there is over \$615 in face value of mint stamps already in the album plus lots of used as well. While obviously not complete, it does include such items as 1970 Cook MS, 1970 ANPEX sheet mint unhinged; 1971 Christmas set of 7 singles mixed mint and used and all the high value definitives mint unhinged, and a great deal of fun ahead for someone wanting to complete this lot. The albums alone new (and these are in as-new condition) would cost more than \$350, as a lot all four volumes with stamps are only **\$699.00**



5. **Queensland 1900 Patriotic Fund** They don't come much better than this! The 1d has minor discoloration where a hinge once was, but the 2d is simply superb and oh so lightly hinged. The pair for **\$325.00**
6. **NSW 1897 Consumptives Home** this is a better than average set, without the toning usually found on this issue. Bright colour too, only **\$189.00**

7. **Victoria 1897 Charity** set of two in mint lightly hinged condition, better than average in fact for ... **\$149.00**
8. **Victoria 1897 Charity overprinted Specimen** a mint lightly hinged set of two and not a trace of toning. The 1d is overprinted in red and the other in black, this pair is rare and very fine **\$179.00**
9. **Victoria 1900 Patriotic Fund** mint lightly hinged set of two, a beautiful fresh set hard to beat ... **\$209.00**
10. **Victoria 1900 Patriotic Fund** mint set with nice centering and no toning, also no gum but that means you save **\$149.00**
11. **Helio-Vaugiard NSW 8d Lyrebird** one of only two Australian stamps included in the famous 1949 series of reproductions by French firm Helio-Vaugiard. This 157x106mm piece is in superb MUH condition (minor fold has been expertly flattened) and would suit either a bird or NSW collector, or anyone interested in rare and unusual philatelic items **\$199.00**

12. **Bahamas** 1901-03 set of three to 2/- (SG 58-60), plus a 3/- from the 1911-19 series (SG 80). A simplified set of nicely centred mint lightly hinged stamps catalogued at £91, the four for **\$59.00**
13. **Bahamas** 1954-63 QEII definitives MLH set of 16 with great fresh colour, a beautiful set **\$25.00**
14. **Cocos (Keeling) Islands** 1989 Melbourne Stamp Show exhibition MS mint unhinged **\$49.00**
15. **Cocos (Keeling) Islands** 1989 World Stamp Expo Washington mint unhinged **\$75.00**
16. **Cocos (Keeling) Islands** 1990 Christmas booklets both types mint unhinged, the pair for **\$29.00**
17. **Jamaica** 1860-70 Queen Victoria definitives simplified set of 6 (SG 1-6) in used condition, plus an extra shade each of the 1d and 2d. These stamps are showing their age but there are no thins, tears, bends, missing perfs or other faults. The basic set of 6 is catalogued at £148 and the two shades are worth at least £96 on their own, all 8 stamps for **\$89.00**
18. **Mauritius** 1969-73 Marine Life definitives (SG 382-99) a diverse range of local water life is depicted on these attractive mint unhinged stamps **\$23.00**
19. **New Guinea** 1932 undated birds overprinted OS (SG O23-35). A brilliant set of either mint unhinged or very lightly hinged stamps with great colour and centering, top quality for **\$249.00**
20. **Nigeria** 1938-51 KGV 4c orange in mint hinged condition. The hardest stamp to get in the series, catalogued at £48, this is well centred too ... **\$25.00**
21. **St Lucia** 1972-73 Pictorials (SG 276-89a) mint unhinged set of 15 **\$12.00**
22. **Samoa** 1972-76 Wildlife definitives (SG 390-99c) complete mint unhinged set of 13 **\$19.00**

WORLD STAMPS

23. **China** 1983 Terracotta Warriors booklet, includes set of four plus MS. Catalogued at US\$75 for **\$49.00**
24. **Finland** 1867 1 Mark very fine used. A rare stamp in any condition, this superb example also has neat and clean rouletted perforations making it a must for any meticulous Finnish collector. Michel number 10 type B (cat. value DM5000) or SG 49 (£700), for **\$699.00**
25. **Finland** 1866 8p black on green in very fine used condition. This Russian administration era stamp is very clean and has full large rouletted perfs, which is extraordinarily scarce for this type of stamp. Michel catalogues it at DM500 (#6 type C) and even Gibbons rates it at £85 (SG 46). It would be very hard to find a better example than this **\$79.00**
26. **French New Hebrides** 1977 local surcharges (SG F247-55) in mint unhinged condition. Only 1500 sets of these provisional issues were made in Port Vila



- and they have a current catalogue value of £550! Also included here are the three values prepared but not put on general sale (50f, 70f and 100f). I have never had a set of these before, and of course such overprinted rarities need certification so this set comes with a Chris Ceremuga guarantee of authenticity. All 12 stamps valued at £760 and so rare, they could be yours for **\$799.00**
27. **Switzerland** 1924 1f20 brown-lake and salmon-pink mint unhinged showing "HFLVETIA" variety (SG 330a). Also listed in Zummstein, only **\$19.00**
28. **Switzerland** 1941 50c olive airmail VFU showing "house with white roof" variety. Zummstein #29.2.03 catalogued at over DM100 for **\$35.00**
29. **Switzerland** 1947 20c Railway Centenary with missing pylon variety (Zumm #279.2.02) in vertical pair with a normal stamp. Both stamps are mint unhinged, the two for **\$69.00**

COLLECTIONS

30. **British Antarctic Territory collection** housed on KaBe hingeless illustrated pages from the first issues of 1963 to the end of 1994, and almost complete. The 1963 definitives (set to 10/-) are mint hinged, but the rest of the collection is mostly CTO. Highlights include: 1971 Explorers complete (cat. £42), 1971 Treaty set, 1977 Whale Conservation, 1984 Marine set, 1990 Fossils set, 1993 Ships complete. With a catalogue value of £486, this is a steal at **\$379.00**
31. **Christmas Island collection** in maroon Seven Seas album covering the period 1958 to end-1993. The 1958 set is MLH but from 1963 everything is mint unhinged (including imprint blocks of four of the 1963 Pictorials). All the sought-after sets are included, such as: Wildlife sheetlet of 16; 1990 Abbott's Booby set plus MS; BirdPex '90 MS; Seabirds IndoPex '93 and Taipei '93 minisheets. There is very very minor toning on the edges of a couple of early stamps, but in the main this is a clean and most attractive collection. Save \$\$\$ off our usual list prices and get the Seven Seas pages too, all for **\$375.00**
32. **Christmas Island collection** fine used and CTO stamps on Seven Seas pages from 1958 to 1990. What a great lot, this collection is complete and includes all of the tougher items (eg. BirdPex '90 MS and the Wildlife sheetlet of 16). There are also some extras from later years up the back, such as the 1992 Shells series all CTO, plus more album pages to 1994 just waiting to be filled. The whole album with stamps just **\$299.00**
33. **Cocos (Keeling) Islands collection** from 1963 to 1994 in mint unhinged condition, there is not much more to do with this great lot. All the standard issues are present, plus extras such as: 1963 definitives in imprint blocks of 4; 1987 Cup-Pex sheetlet of 16; \$5 Airmail overprint; Provisionals set of 7 (incl. 1 CTO). This standard collection is complete except for one set (1993 Early Currency) and would cost \$680 if bought separately, buy them here for **\$399.00**
34. **Cocos (Keeling) Islands collection** all CTO stamps from 1963 to the end of 1993, housed on Seven Seas pages. The standard issues are complete except for three sets, but this great lot also includes some unusual and better items such as: 1955 Cocos-Australia First Flight cover; 8 Australian 1966 bird and fish definitives cancelled in Cocos Islands; 1987 Cup-Pex sheetlet; 1990 \$5 Aircraft CTO and the 1990-91 Provisionals full set of 7 CTO (scarce). The whole collection only **\$399.00**
35. **Papua New Guinea collection** in brown Seven Seas album with slipcase from 1952 to 1994. This is another beauty! The 1952 Pictorials are not complete but the 10/- and £1 specimens are present MUH. The other pre-decimals are mixed mint hinged and unhinged, and from 1966 onwards everything is superb mint unhinged. The stamps alone would cost over \$650 if bought separately, not to mention the album and pages at over \$200, this fine collection is an absolute bargain for only **\$549.00**
