AUSTRALIA



- 2000 The Last Anzacs error** this is the first modern error of colour for almost 10 years, and what a beauty! Two units of some booklets of 10 (each featuring Alec Campbell) were printed with gold omitted, while the other 8 received their colour as normal. We have previously only offered this as a full booklet (containing two error units), but we can now offer a single stamp to put in your album. This lot actually includes a normal stamp from the same booklet, still attached, so the mistake is even more apparent. Modern decimal errors are hot and this is so rare, get it now for **\$499.00**
- Lighthouse illustrated albums** two as-new red binders with slipcases containing hingeless illustrated pages for Australia from 1966-1999. There are no stamps, but at less than half the recommended retail prices of new albums, they won't last long! One set only for **\$169.00**
- KGV 1d red die III with thin "US" retouched** What a rarity! This mint lightly hinged stamp clearly shows the third state of this variety (ACSC 75mb) and the colour is great too. The latest BW catalogue values this stamp at \$1250, yours for **\$899.00**
- 1914 6d Engraved Kookaburra** block of four with top selvage showing plate No. 1, in amazing condition for its age. Only the selvage is hinged leaving the four stamps all pristine MUH, and there is not a trace of toning anywhere. Hard to find, for **\$599.00**
- 1929 1½d WA Centenary** a full set of 12 plate blocks of four in mint hinged and unhinged condition. There are only minor faults on the reverse of a couple of pieces, but from the front they look great. ACSC catalogue value over \$165 for **\$79.00**
- 1930 1½d Sturt Centenary** a full set of 8 plate blocks in mint condition. As above there is the odd crease or mark on the back, but overall they look great **\$49.00**
- 1932 3d Harbour Bridge** full set of four plate blocks in mint condition. A partial separation at the left of Plate 1 is the only fault worth mentioning, these are otherwise very clean and nice for only **\$85.00**

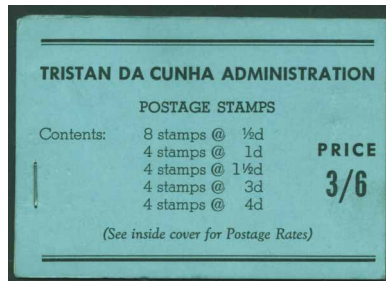


- 1932 5/- Harbour Bridge** a mint hinged example with natural gum ageing, and bright colour (see photo). Get this Australian classic for **\$329.00**

BRITISH COMMONWEALTH

- British Antarctic Territory** 1963-69 definitives set complete (SG1-15a) in mint condition. These well centred stamps are mixed hinged and unhinged, and yes the £1 red and black is unhinged (cat. £150). A very fine lot **\$249.00**

- British Indian Ocean Territory** the first set of 15 overprints on Seychelles (SG 1-15) in MUH condition, they are well centred too **\$45.00**
- Cayman Islands** 1974 Pictorials featuring fish and various pirate treasure images. The whole set is mint unhinged and perfect for **\$45.00**
- Ceylon** 1935-36 KGV definitives the 3c value mint hinged in both perforations (SG 369 and 369a). In fact not just the perfs but the colours of each stamp are distinctly different, the pair for **\$15.00**
- Gambia** 1963 Birds set of 13 (SG 193-205). A beautiful mint unhinged set of these first self-government issues, cat. value £70 only **\$79.00**
- Malawi** 1968 Birds set complete (SG 310-23) mint unhinged. While some of the low values do have some minor toning on the reverse, from the front these stamps look great **\$75.00**
- Montserrat** 1970-74 Birds definitives set of 14 in mint unhinged condition. A marvellously illustrated and colourful set catalogued at £35, now **\$28.00**
- Norfolk Island** 10/- Bird on registered first day cover ("14AU61"). A superb clean item **\$39.00**
- Papua New Guinea** 1952 £1 Fisherman in MUH left corner imprint block of 4. A well centred block this, with light hinging on the selvage only, what a great centrepiece item for your collection! **\$189.00**
- Samoa** 1967-69 decimal definitives (SG 280-89b) featuring local bird life, the set MUH **\$39.00**
- Solomon Islands** 1940 Postage Dues set of 8 in mint hinged condition. These stamps are well centred and the colour is as good as the day they were printed, catalogue value £85 now **\$55.00**



- Tristan Da Cunha 1957 booklet** (photo reduced to 55% of original size) SB1a this is the first booklet, postmarked "JA 24 58" on the back. Catalogued at £300, for **\$399.00**
- Tristan Da Cunha 1957 booklet** SB1b similar to above, but with no postmark on the back ... **\$249.00**
- Tristan Da Cunha 1958 booklet** SB2, the same stamps as above but with the bright red and black cover, catalogue value £65 for **\$59.00**
- Tristan Da Cunha 1960 booklet** SB3 **\$35.00**
- Tristan Da Cunha 1965 booklet** SB4 the last booklet ever released, unfortunately this one has a couple of pen marks on the cover **\$10.00**

COLLECTIONS

- Australian Frama collection** mint and used framas on Seven Seas hingeless pages with matching binder. Starting with the full set of first trial Bar framas from 1984 (21), this collection includes MUH sets of most different papers, ie: second Bar 33c set of 9; Kangaroo set of 27; 36c Platypus set of 9; 37c, 50c and \$1 Platypus set of 27; Echidna set of 27; 39c Possum set of 27; Lizard set of 27; Koala set of 27 (two sets); Emu set of 27 and Waratah set of 27. At the back are several used sets (many off FDCs) such as 33c Bar set of 27; Kangaroo (27); 36c Platypus (27); Echidna (27); and 39c Possum (27). Also includes lots of varieties eg. \$00.00; double prints; entirely blank units; plus heaps of commemoratives. An amazing lot, buy and save 20% off our list price for the MUH sets alone! All for **\$399.00**

- Fiji FDC collection** covers the period 1979 to 1996, but mostly from 1990 onwards. All the covers are very clean and neat, featuring sets like: 1990 Freshwater Fishes; 1991 Crabs; 1992 Expo; 1993 Nudibranches; 1995 Land Birds definitives to \$5 (two covers); 1996 Olympihlex MS, and many more. Over 50 FDCs catalogued at over £300 housed in as-new Vario Plus binder with 13 leaves (worth \$50 RRP alone), the lot **\$125.00**
- Niue collection** mixed lot of mint and CTO stamps on Lindner pages and New Age springback binder. These are all quite recent stamps, from Christmas 1977 to the mid-1990s, mostly CTO although with the odd MUH set thrown in too, such as: 1983 Whales set CTO (£15); 1986 Papal Visit set plus both MS CTO (£35); 1986 Stampex Birds set of 8 CTO (£26); 1990 World Cup Football MUH set (£11); 1994 Moon Landing Anniversary strip MUH (£16). Overall there is almost £300 catalogue value here, yes it is an unusual lot but so cheap at **\$159.00**
- Niue collection** in as-new Vario Plus binder with 20 leaves. Mostly modern First Day Covers, however there is a lovely 1937 KGV Coronation registered FDC in superb clean condition. The majority of covers are from 1989-96 such as: 150th Anniversary of Postage Stamp set plus MS (also the MS alone both MUH and CTO); \$10 BirdPex '90 FDC; 1992 Birds set of 8 on four covers; 1992 Olympics MS MUH, CTO and FDC; 1993 WWF Dolphins FDC; 1993 Birds on FDC including Officials to \$15; plus lots more taking the cat. value of the used stamps alone to almost £500! The album and pages alone are worth over \$75 new, the whole collection for **\$199.00**
- Pitcairn Islands collection** housed in blue Seven Seas binder and slipcase with illustrated pages from 1940 to 1994. Virtually nothing else to do, except give it a good home! This collection has one of each stamp issued for Pitcairn right up until mid-1994 in superb CTO (or occasionally mint) condition. The 1940 KGV set is actually present both mint and used, the 1948 Silver Wedding and 1949 UPU sets are perfect, and all the other stamps are very fine as well. Some extra values are included with certain definitive sets, and there is even the inverted watermark set of 1970 Fishes. With only minor gum toning on some early values that is not apparent from the front, this collection is simply superb and a true bargain. Catalogued at over £600, save 20% off our list price and get the Seven Seas album for free **\$475.00**
- Samoa collection** from Independence in 1962 until the end of 1994. This mostly CTO collection is housed on Seven Seas pages in two volumes, and is more than 90% complete (I counted only 11 sets or minisheets missing out of 32 years worth of stamps). While the 1965 Kava Bowl watermark set is absent, this collection does include: 1967 decimal definitive set mostly used to \$2; 1972-76 Nature definitives complete (£27); 1983-84 Fruit definitives complete (£26); and the 1988-89 Birds definitives to \$20 (£20). The condition of the stamps is generally excellent, with very minor toning on only a handful of earlier issues. There is more than £375 catalogue value here, and you could pay over \$700 from some other dealers if bought separately. Buy the lot and save \$\$\$, plus get the pages too for only **\$349.00**
