- 1914 6d Engraved Kookaburra** I don't need to say more than look at the picture at left! This stamp is mint unhinged and well centred and has bright fresh colour too. The first stamp of the Commonwealth that did not feature KGV or a kangaroo, it is one of the key pre-decimal Aust. stamps **\$185.00**
- Second watermark kangaroos** a complete set of used stamps, including a superb 6d and a nice 5/- (and the others are pretty good too). Save almost a third off our list price, all 7 for **\$329.00**
- 1934 Macarthur set** including the 2d Dark Hills, all MUH and perfect. Don't pay up to 40% extra for good centering, this set of 4 is only **\$72.50**
- 3d blue KGV1** five different die and paper varieties of this key stamp (not including the White Wattles) can be yours at once with this brilliant MUH group. We've saved you the hard work and made it easy to slip them straight in your album and they are well centred too, all 5 for **\$239.00**
- 1937-56 KGV1 Zoologicals** these attractive animal stamps (kangaroo, koala, platypus etc) were released in three different perf and wmk combinations, this is the lot (18 stamps) in MUH condition **\$69.00**
- 1938-49 Robes set** the full set in both thick and thin paper (6 stamps) in MUHWC condition **\$239.00**
- 1963-65 Navigators** full set of 8 stamps MUH, including white paper 10/- and £1 **\$239.00**
- 1963 Royal Visit error** the 5d value massively misperfed, a very attractive variety MUH **\$29.00**



- Second watermark kangaroos perf OS** all 6 stamps in used condition, good centering for OS stamps and all with commercial CDS cancels. The whole set (yes this price is right) for **\$249.00**
- 1963 KGV 5d chestnut perf OS** single crown wmk rough paper (SG O60) a very fine used stamp centred off to the left only and such intense colour **\$99.00**
- First watermark kangaroos perf OS** complete set up to 1/- in used condition. While some values are only average used condition, this set does include a nice example of the scarce 2½d indigo (right) plus a 4d orange with neat corner CDS. All 10 stamps (SG O1-10) at a huge discount to our list price **\$239.00**
- B.C.O.F. set** all 7 stamps in great mint unhinged condition and the 5/- is actually the thin paper variety. All stamps are well centred too, for **\$159.00**
- 1975 18c Wildflower black omitted** a mint unhinged block of four (SG 608a), all units missing the 18c and country name that black normally provides. There are a couple of nibbled perfs at top but this variety really does look better in a block, and it can be yours for **\$169.00**



- 1981 24c Thylacine imperf pair** a mint unhinged vertical pair (SG 788a). Listed in Stanley Gibbons, this is a striking variety that I have not seen for a long time. Nice & clean **\$299.00**
- 1973 7c Agate black omitted** a mint jointed horizontal pair of this popular error, one unit MUH. They're a bit dusty from poor storage but are not toned. Cat. £80 per stamp for only **\$129.00**



COMMONWEALTH & WORLD STAMPS

- 1949 UPU World Omnibus** this is a rare opportunity to obtain an entire collection of the UPU's 75th Anniversary stamps in a sturdy and attractive custom made album. Produced by the Union of South Africa's Postmaster, it contains MUH stamps from 179 different postal authorities such as: Albania, Austria, Ascension, Berlin (cat. value £475), Hong Kong, Honduras, Iran, Italy, Japan (including a mint air letter), Lebanon, Luxembourg, Monaco, Pitcairn Island, Macao, San Marino (no MS), Syria, Vatican City, Spanish Morocco, Allied Zone Germany - the list goes on and on and of course it includes every single Commonwealth stamp issued for the commemoration. Over £1750 catalogue value for the stamps alone plus the uniqueness of its origin from a well-known postal authority make this a must-have for any serious omnibus collector. Professional design and binding have ensured it's still in as-new condition and don't forget the stamps are perfect MUH **\$1999.00**
- Great Britain 1935 KGV Jubilee booklet** in superb condition, full stitching and all panes present and accounted for, only **\$95.00**
- Great Britain 1939-48 KGV1** high values the 2/6, 5/- and 10/- ultramarine values only in blocks of four each with 2 MUH and 2 MLH units. These well centred blocks would look great with the full set or on a display frame, over £200 value for **\$119.00**
- Great Britain 1940 Stamp Centenary FDC** featuring all 6 stamps on RPS cover and red exhibition cancels. Cat. value of £45 for a standard FDC, this ... **\$40.00**
- Great Britain 1948 Anniversary of Liberation of Channel Islands FDC** on souvenir cover **\$20.00**
- Great Britain 1948 Olympic Games FDC** on illustrated cover, a little rubbed at left but still very attractive with Wembley cancels. £38 value for **\$25.00**
- Great Britain 1949 UPU Anniversary FDC** featuring the full set on a private cover **\$45.00**
- Great Britain 1963 Freedom From Hunger phosphor bands set** of 2 mint unhinged (SG 634p/5p), catalogued at £36 for **\$35.00**
- Great Britain 1963 Ninth International Lifeboat Conference phosphor bands set** of 3 MUH (SG 639p/41p), with selvage on two of the stamps to make the bands even more apparent **\$69.00**
- Great Britain 1963 Red Cross Centenary phosphor bands set** of three mint unhinged **\$99.00**
- Great Britain decimals** new pricelist now available on our website, or call us and we will post it to you!
- Hong Kong** some booklets from 1985, SB 18 and SB 19, plus a \$13 booklet produced by the Crown Agents but not available for general sale in Hong Kong. All three booklets available for **\$49.00**
- Tonga 1897 definitives** a simplified set of 14 (SG 38a/53a). These stamps are in average mint condition however they do look good from the front, minimum catalogue value of £200 for only **\$129.00**

COLLECTIONS

- Great Britain collection** a fantastic mostly used collection from 1840 to 1975, housed in a Windsor illustrated springback album. This is one of the best GB collections I have seen in a long time, and while it is not complete it does contain heaps and heaps of the key stamps and scarcities such as: 3-margin Penny Black with red maltese cancel; 2d blue no lines with black maltese cross; 9 1d red perforated stamps with different plate numbers (including 135); 11 1870 ½d rose stamps including plates 4, 8 and 20; 1855-70 4d rose and 6d lilac (SG 66 and 70) both nicely used; 1883-84 high values simplified set of three used (cat. £625); 1883 9d and 1/- heavily used but clean and intact (cat. £375 and £200 respectively). In the King Edward VII section are more than 20 assorted used stamps including three different 2/6 stamps and a fine used 5/-; the KGV section has dozens of stamps particularly from the 1912-24 period up to 1/- plus a complete set of 1934-36 definitives used, but also various early seahorses to 10/- and a set of 1934 re-engraved seahorses (cat. £175). From 1937 the KGV1 section is absolutely complete in mostly mint condition (although the 10/- dark blue is thinned), and the QEII stamps are 95% complete up to 1975 (simplified basis) in mixed mint and used condition. For good measure, up the back are a few pages of watermark varieties such as 1912 KGV ½d green wmk inverted and reversed mint with selvage, 1929 UPU inverted wmk used and lots of odd KGV1 and QEII stamps mint and used inverted wmk. This brilliant album would form the basis of a great new collection or add enormously to any collection already under way, the total catalogue value is a massive £6600+ but the whole lot can be yours for only **\$2300.00**
- Hong Kong collection** mixed lot of mint and used definitive stamps on springback album pages including: 21 King Edward VII used up to \$1 in different wmk; assorted used KGV1 definitives to 50c plus 1946 Victory set MLH; 1954-62 QEII definitives mint hinged to 50c. Over £135 catalogue value for **\$79.00**
- Malta collection** mint and used stamps from 1885-1967 on looseleaf album pages. This mixed bag is by no means complete but does include: 7 different King Edward VII used to 1/-; over 30 mostly used KGV stamps to 6d; 1937 KGV1 definitives to 1/- mint and used (2 sets); 1948 Self-Government set to 2/6 mint/used; 1956 QEII definitives mint to 2/- plus a few QEII comms. The total cat.value is over £75, all only **\$49.00**
- New Zealand collection** on looseleaf album pages from 1909 to 1955 in mint and used. This is a very nice little lot featuring: 1909 King Edward VII complete set simplified avg used; 19 different KGV heads both printings up to 1/- in mint and used; 1936-42 Pictorials simplified set used; 1936 Commerce set mint; KGV1 definitives used (17) plus extra mint blocks of four of some values; 1939 Express used; 1940 Centennial set used (no 7d); 1946 Peace set mint and used; most of the cheaper comms mint from late 40s to late 50s; QEII definitives mint to 9d plus a used 5/-; 1947 Lighthouses MLH to 6d plus various Health stamps mint/used from the late 1930s to mid 1950s. There is quite a bit of toning throughout but mainly on the used stamps, and with a minimum catalogue value over £120 this fun lot is great value for **\$69.00**
- Omnibus collection** selected Commonwealth omnibus issues from the KGV1 and early QEII period housed on quadrille pages in a springback binder. Of course it's not complete, however it does provide a good start to many major omnibus sets and has: 1937 KGV1 Coronation 70% complete mint and used (includes Hong Kong set MLH); 1946 Victory set half complete in mint condition; 1948 Silver Wedding low values almost complete mint; 1951 British West Indies University College complete set MLH; 1953 Coronation 70% complete in mint. There is minor toning on a few stamps but overall the condition is excellent and just look at the price, the whole lot for **\$69.00**
