61. <u>AUSTRALIA</u> In Royal Blue Seven Seas hingeless album covering the period 1913-1965. The vast majority of the

collection is fine used—I noted Kangaroos assorted (24) various watermarks including 5d Large OS first wmk Roo average used, 5/- small Multiple wmk Roo average used, KGV assorted to 1/4 mostly average to fine used odd mint as well more than 60 different, assorted perf. OS etc. 1914 on a fine used 6d Engraved Kooka, 1927-1965 is actually complete by the Seven Seas layout except for the thin paper robes, so Navigators are a mixture of MUH £2 and £1 Cream paper, the other values are fine used. Buying just stamps with a retail value of more than \$10 each, you would spend more than \$900 buying these stamps, all the others are free. The first page of the album needs a couple of mounts replaced but the rest of the album (new costs \$160+) is in excellent condition, much loved even has hole reinforcements. The 5/- Bridge in this album is actually commercially used, 10 times rarer than a cto. Pages are rust free and the stamps are in excellent shape, either build on or break it down for your own collection,\$449.00

62. GREECE 2 Volume Davo illustrated albums covering the period 1861-1988. Albums have the odd tone spots but as most of the stamps are used. There are loads of other printed pages containing stamps from Crete, Epirus, Samos, basically all in very good condtion. I noted 1896 Olympics to 2d fine sued, 1901 set complete mixture mint and used, 1928 SG 430 Mint, 1927 SG 406-9 fine used, 1933 Airs SG 461-7 sets of 7 fine used £95, 1933 Zeppelin set fine used £110, 1933 Airs SG 468-74 complete (7) £100, 1935-39 Airs fine used (9) SG 480-88 £150 fine used, 1939 Airs SG 544-53 fine sued complete (10) £350, 1954 Bati SG 725-27 mint (3) £140, The list goes on and on, there are hundreds of stamps in these lovely albums with a Cat. Value of just the £10+ stamps (all the rest are free) hundreds of them. Cat.
