20. ICELAND - 3 x extraordinary volumes in like new Davo illustrated hingeless albums covering the period 1873-2014, brand new albums would cost \$900+-. A mixture of mostly very fresh mint and very fine used. The early period includes - a lot of full sets including some blocks, strips etc on top of the fact that the collection is basically 98% complete from 1902 to 2014. Includes 120++booklets, plus peel and stick, miniature sheets and loads of extras I really have never seen before! There is minor duplication however with a Catalogue value in excess £13,000++ (Aust - \$22,000++) this only includes the better stock, anything under £10 does not even get included in this total for (images reduced) the lot.....**\$ 4,250.00**

18. AUSTRALIA—5 HUGE VOLUMES OF DECIMAL LIGHTHOUSE ALBUMS All hingeless with matching slipcases (RED) covering the period 1966-2020.. In as new condition which would **cost \$2,495** just for the empty albums to buy new. There is **more than \$3,535.00+ just in face value** of Mint unhinged stamps included in these albums which are very comprehensively complete to around 2018. From 2019-2020 these are in need of completion. One magnificent lot to build upon and upgrade any cheaper standard albums you might have for decimal Australia for less than the albums would cost you, a gift**\$ 2,499.00**



21. SOLOMON ISLAND 1907-1984, This lovely collection is housed in two old time album pages mostly in black mounts. The collection is a mixture of mint and fine used. I noted a mixed mint and used set of Large Canoes, all mint except 1/2d and 2d which are both fine used £300, there is a second set of large canoes all used except the 5d and 1/- which are both mint and actually forgeries which look great. 1908 Small Canoes complete SG 7-17 mixture of mint and used £270, GV Specimens SG 18/21s £85, 1914-23 KGV to £1 a mixture of mint and fine used, £1 if used Cat. Of this group is £470, 1922-31 assorted mint and fine used to 10/- Cat. Is £340, from 1935 on a most comprehensive collection right up to 1984 with mint, fine used, FDC's a massive lot in fact, varieties, shades, Specimens including Postage Dues D1/8 £250, Specimen Victory £110 mint, loads of wmk inverted including gutter blocks. This fine collection could easily be enhanced by simply re-housing them, no rust or toning on the pages but would look prettier more displayed. There is a fine collection of Booklets which you seldom see from the Solomons in fine condition Cat. £300+ just for pre-1970 booklets. The catalogue value of the collection is more than £3,500+ (over \$6,000 Aust!) on just the better higher catalogued stamps One nice buy for someone wishing to really study this area (images reduced).....**\$ 729.00**

(3) AIF complete (4), 1949 Arms complete (4) all commems 2/3 etc, Navigators complete to £2 (6) BCOF set complete (7) 5/- is thick paper, plus loads of others for the period, about 90% complete.
