Right up to the Tablet issues which are to 10/mostly fiscal examples with a few mint lower values, 1899-1900 Pictorials to 6 d , pages of them, mint used on piece, private perfins, wmk varieties, different printings, 155++ different, Postal Fiscals to $2 / 6$ mostly used perf varieties, Revenues. 30. PAPUA NEW GUINEA OVERPRINTS DEALERS LOT! This extraordinary lot is in amazingly fresh condition and would be wonderful for a part time or full time dealer to either add to stock or sell at wholesale prices via stamp shows etc. anyway here we go-When I first looked at this lot I was amazed... It does include- many 1000's of stamps, all MUH or CTO and mostly in large blocks and full sheets....varieties, I noted amongst other things, hundreds of sets of the 1992-3 Birds overprints first printing, includes Kapul overprints in the margins everywhere which sell for $\$ 15$ per set, plate varieties worth the research. Minor double overprints, There are at least 50 full perfect sheets cto of the 5 t Baing End from the 1995 overprints, fish overprinted sets $3 \times 100$ 's, Trekking adventure missing 65t in blocks of 12 with the variety at least 25++ blocks all MUH which sell for $\$ 60$ per block. Papal overprints by the 100's, 100's of the first two overprints seen for \$17 a pair on other lists. There are notes everywhere listing plate flaws etc. musical bow partial 5t missing, half and full sheets. There are crammed stockbooks, sheet folders everywhere. Saw quite a few complete second overprinted birds ( $\$ 200$ per set retail!) in blocks - 6 complete sets in fact plus-It includes a large block of 10 of the 50t Gogodola Mask so there are at least 10 complete MUH sets of this scarce issue - 1994 SG 73040 (selling for at least $\$ 150$ per set!) plus hundreds and hundreds of short set and complete sets.
