22. PRE-DECIMAL AUST 1914-1965

housed in maroon black paged KABE stock book. This collection was put together for a gentleman's grandson, long ago who sadly did not decide to pursue the hobby. Now there is a lot of

toning and rust in this collection but with a bit of serious work, even if you soaked off the gum on some of the stamps to preserve them it would be financially worthwhile. I noted blocks of 4, 6d Engraved Kooka SG19, a block of the 1928

Kooka miniature sheet but also a full block four blocks of four so in fact 4 x extra miniature sheets. Have not had these like this for some time, the bottom right selvedge is a slightly broken but it looks great for presentation purposes as well. I also noted blocks and imprints of 1/- large Lyre SG 140, SG 146 6d Large Kooka, blocks of OS overprinted 2d and 3d Bridge issues, plus a mint hinged (thinned) 5/- Bridge. There is a nice set of Arms imprints, the £2 has the retouch and just minor toning plus a mint hinged complete set, 1/- Anzac John Ash imprint block 4 (toned) plus a single, Robes Thick paper £1 John Ash imprint block minor toning, 10/- Authority Imprint unHINGED fresh, 2/- Jubilee plate one top right block, stamps unHINGED minor separation at right, fresh, Macarthur imprints toned needs gum removed, included dark hills imprints, 1/- Victoria Imprint toned, 1936 South Australia imprints 1/- x 2 blocks toned, Sesquicentenary set in blocks four toned, 1940 AIF imprint 6d toned, Navigators in blocks of four up to £2 two hinged and two unmounted, extras including another set both papers mint. BCOF is an interesting full page including a toned 5/- thin paper hinged, blocks and imprints on 6d, 1/- and 2/- with some annotated varieties. The book is full of hundreds of stamps, sets and com-mems that will reward with the work involved. I found a minimum of \$4,000 worth of stock if the stamps were not toned however an eBay trader will do really well with this or a grandfather who wants to encourage a grandchild to this area of collecting, the lot bargain just (images reduced).....**\$1,329.00**

Mult 13 1/2 x 12 1/2—4d Olive, 4 1/2d, 5d Brown, 1/4 Blue CofA mint, all overprinted OS complete set fresh mint. 1914 on MLH of all the following 6d Engraved Kooka, 1928 Kooka Miniature sheet, 1/6 Hermes No wmk MUH, Kingsford Smith OS MUH set, 5/- Bridge mlh superb, Vict. Cent MLH 10 1/2 set, Macarthur set (4) MLH, 1/- Anzac MLH, 2/- Jubilee MUH, 3d Blue KGV1 die 1 MUH, 10/- and £1 Robes thick paper superb MUH, Arms MUH set (4) 5/- Cattle cream and white paper MUH, 1963-4 Navigators set (6) MUH. Berlin has a nice selection 1948-49 including Fine used SG B33 £700 top left perf missing, SG B34 used bottom left perf missing Cat. £350, B61-3 fine used set £225, B35-53 complete fine used £75, Bells fine used 1951 4 or 5 fine used £130, 1951-52 Bells B82-86 used complete £110, 1953 Bells B101-105 complete mint £100. Very few toned stamps in this lovely lot with a Cat. value of £4,500+ (\$9,250 Aust) just for the better stamps so a lot a not included in the Cat. value, nice buy, images reduced..... **\$ 599.00**
